The present workshop aims to inform mental health professionals and offer specialized knowledge in the neuropsychology of major depression and schizophrenia which will assist them in their clinical practice and research.

### LEARNING OUTCOMES OF THE CLINICAL WORKSHOP SCHIZOPHRENIA

- \* Understand the course of cognitive function and cognitive decline in schizophrenia
- \* Research evidence of the neuropsychology of schizophrenia and its importance for clinical practice
- \* The relationship between cognitive dysfunction (i.e. attention, verbal memory) and clinical symptoms of schizophrenia
- \* The assessment of IQ, memory, attention, executive function, psychomotor speed in schizophrenia (how do we select particular neuropsychological measurements in order to evaluate cognitive function in schizophrenia?)
- \* Cognitive rehabilitation in schizophrenia
- \* Cognitive-behavioural techniques in the management of schizophrenia
- \* Neuropsychological management in schizophrenia
