Master of Arts (Honours) Education

What is it about?

This is a new, exciting and forward-thinking four year undergraduate degree programme, developed from years of experience and expertise in the field of education and reflects many of the current national and international educational priorities. The programme is accredited by the General Teaching Council for Scotland and it is a highly-respected teaching qualification which enables graduates to teach throughout much of Europe, the UK and beyond.

It provides an excellent opportunity to prepare for a professional career in education which addresses a wide range of knowledge and skills, whilst also exploring the associated values, attitudes and professionalism expected of a modern classroom teacher.

Athens based students will undertake three core modules related to the Greek curriculum. These will address; Greek language, Greek literature and culture and Greek history.

Who is it for?

The Master of Arts in Education (Honours) is a programme that has been developed for applicants wishing to qualify to work as a professional Primary School teacher.

How is it delivered?

The programme offers a stimulating mix of lectures, workshops, seminars, discussion groups and tutorials together with online learning opportunities. Thirty weeks of the programme will be undertaken in school-based and other work-based settings from nursery school and throughout the primary years, with the opportunity for some of this time to be spent in another workplace setting of your own choice. There is even the opportunity to undertake a placement abroad if you wish.
