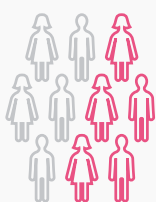


# Attitudes of Europeans towards Air Quality

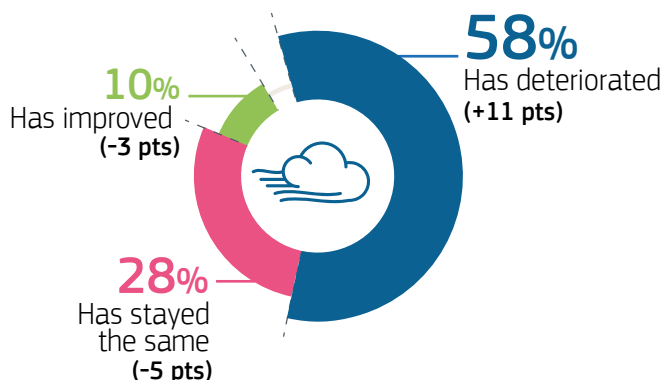

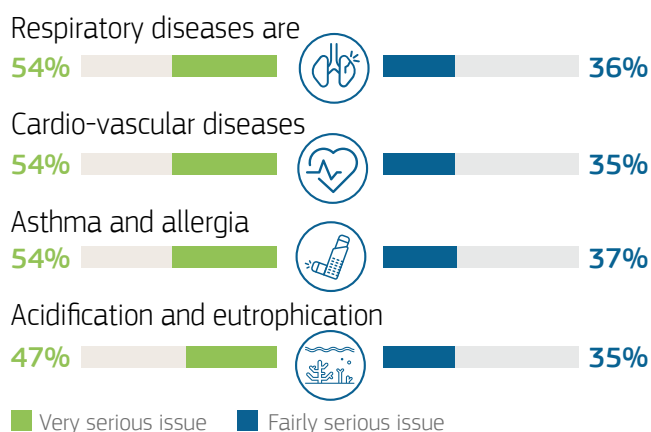

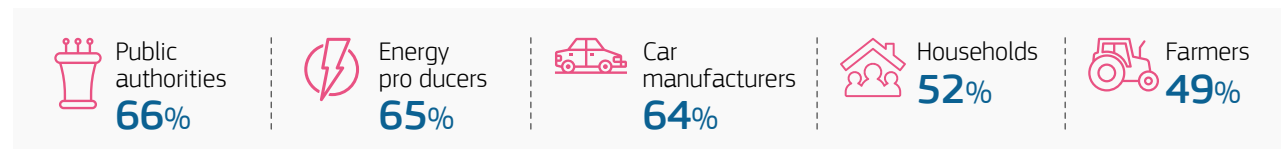
They have change their **home heating system** to a lower-emission system

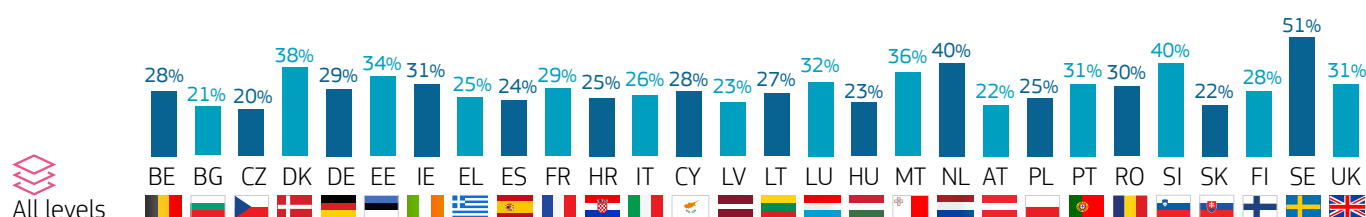
... BUT THEY THINK **MORE SHOULD BE DONE** TO PROMOTE GOOD AIR QUALITY

They think the following actors **are not doing enough**

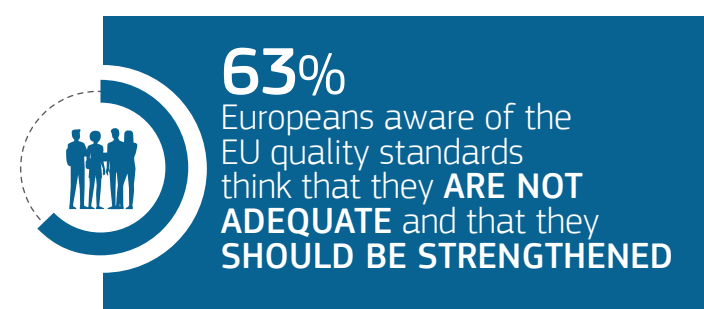


A MAJORITY OF EUROPEANS WANT MORE ACTIONS AT **THE INTERNATIONAL LEVEL**
